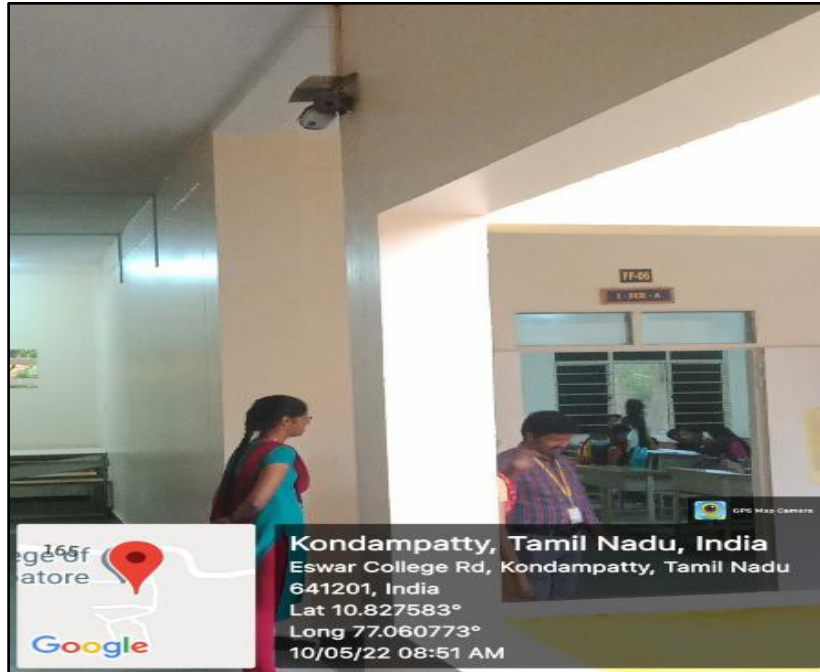


Fig 2: CCTV camera near class rooms covering all the Corridors

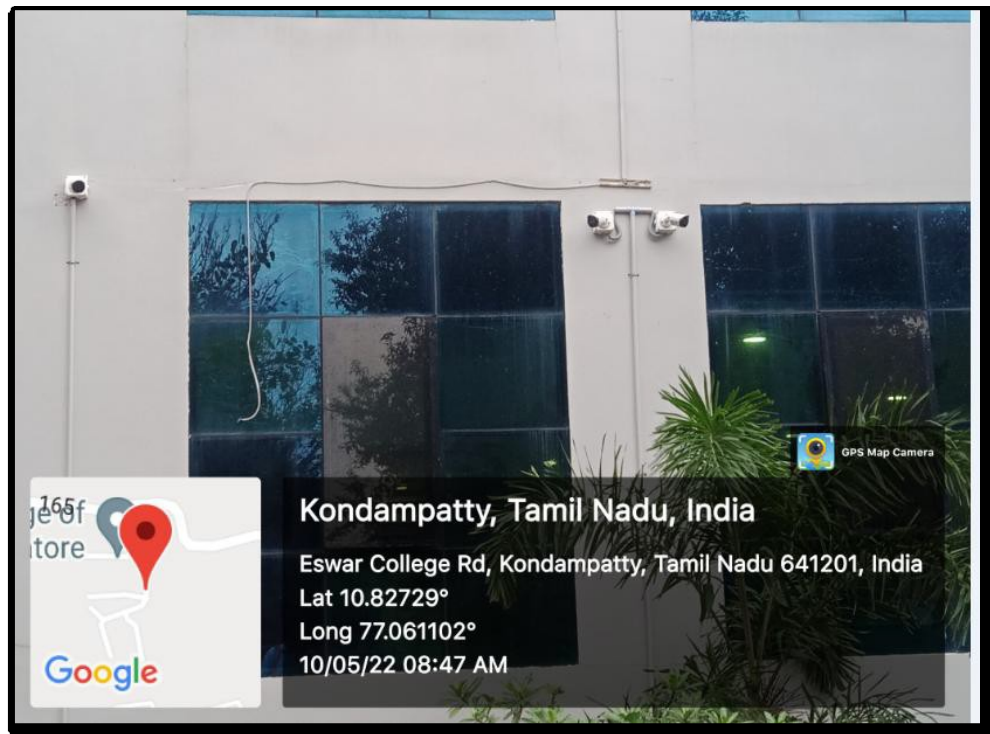


Fig 3: CCTV camera near amenity covering the entire campus

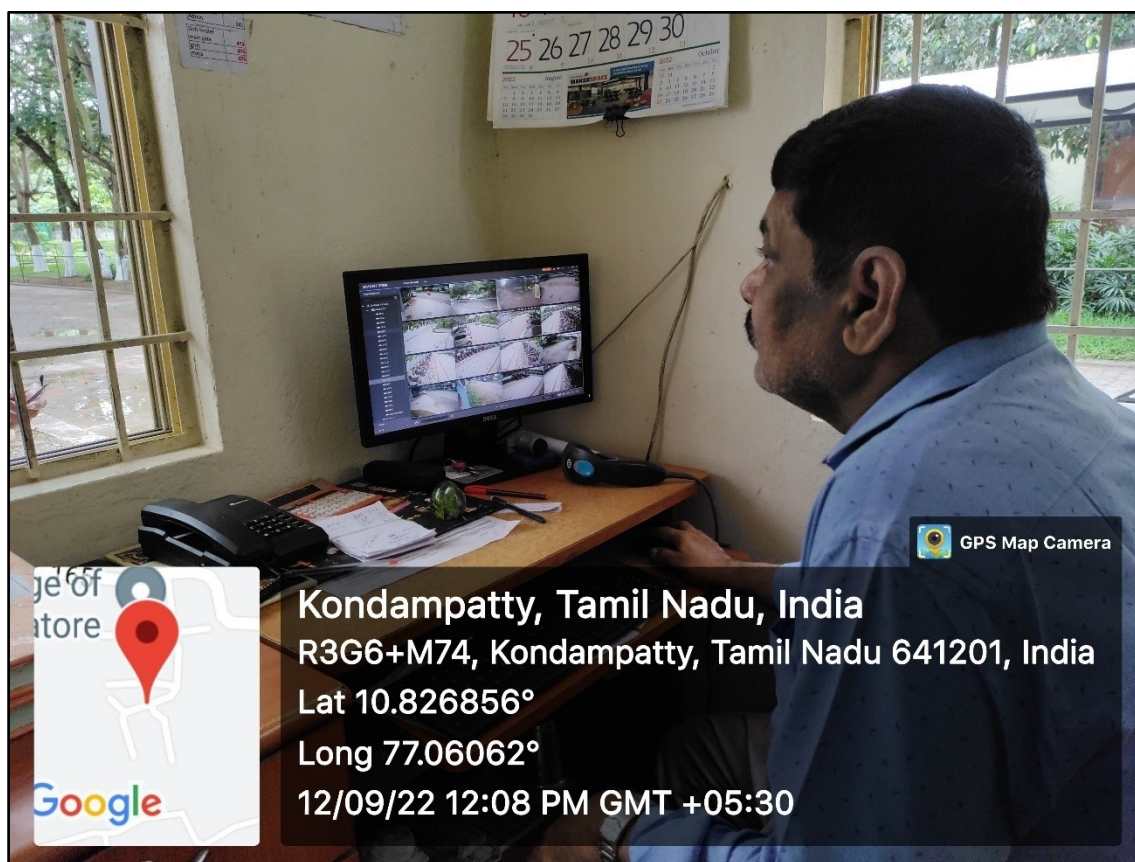


Fig 4: Hostel Warden monitoring the CCTV

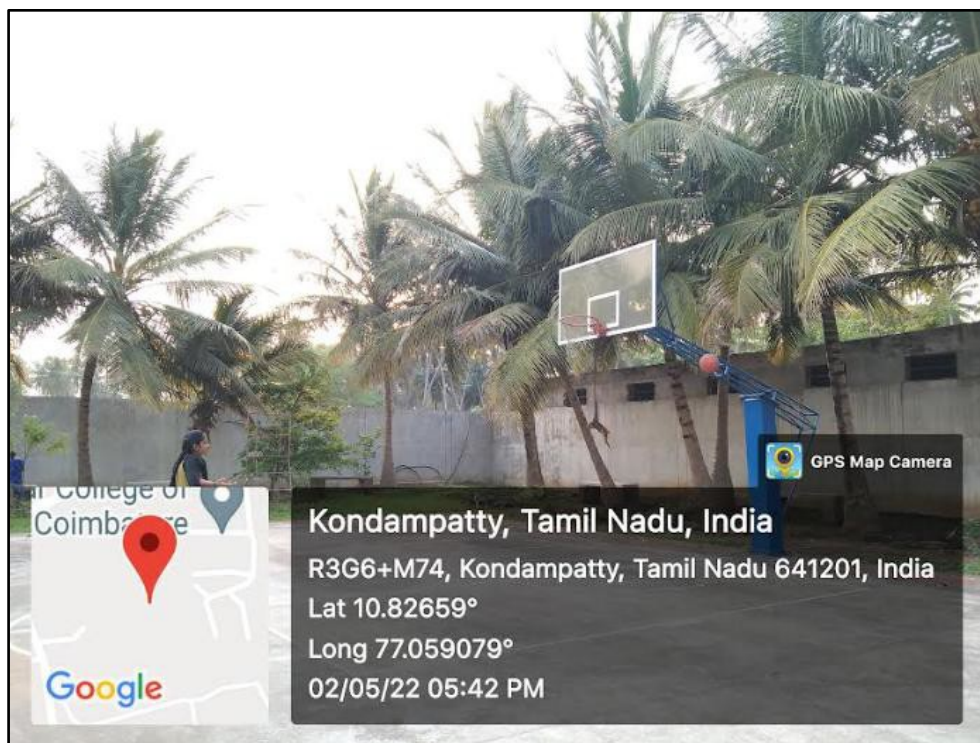


Fig 6: Sports for refreshing the minds of girl students

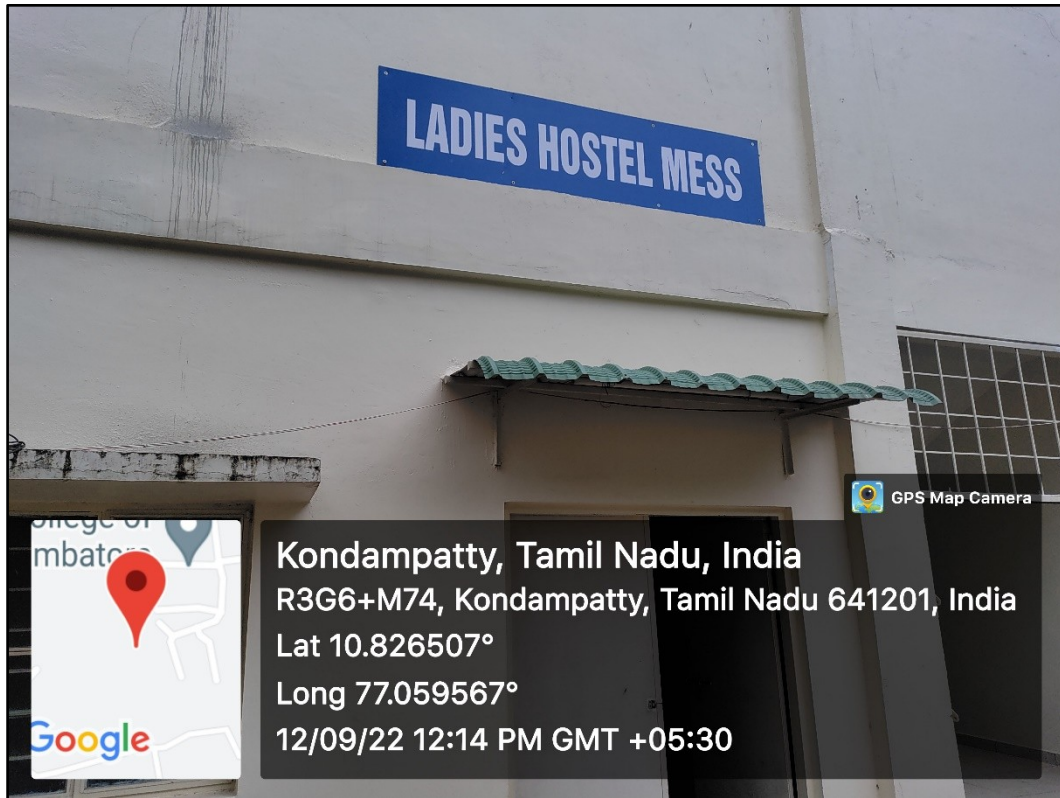


Fig 9: Ladies Hostel Mess inside the institute

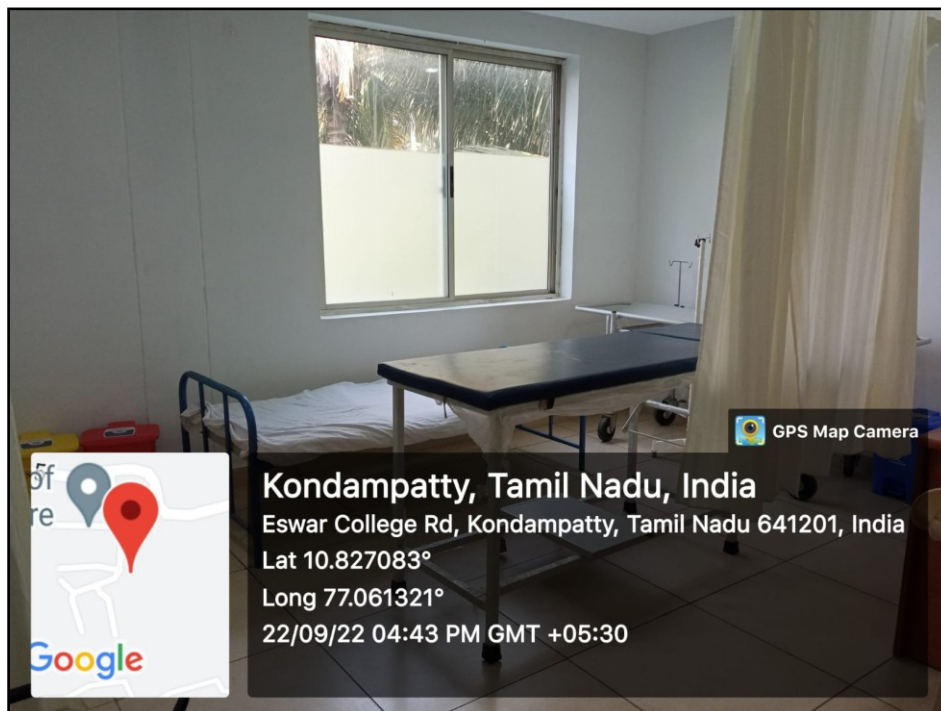


Fig 15: Bed Facilities at Medical Centre

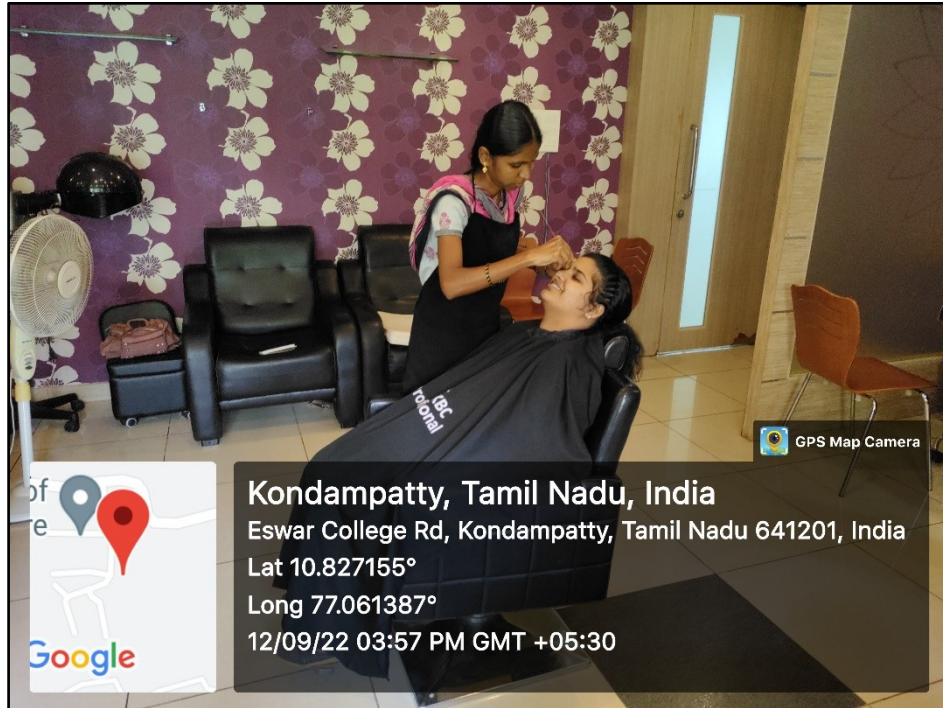


Fig 14: Ladies Beauty Parlour

An electric vehicle has been arranged for the girl students to move to hostel for lunch and to come back.

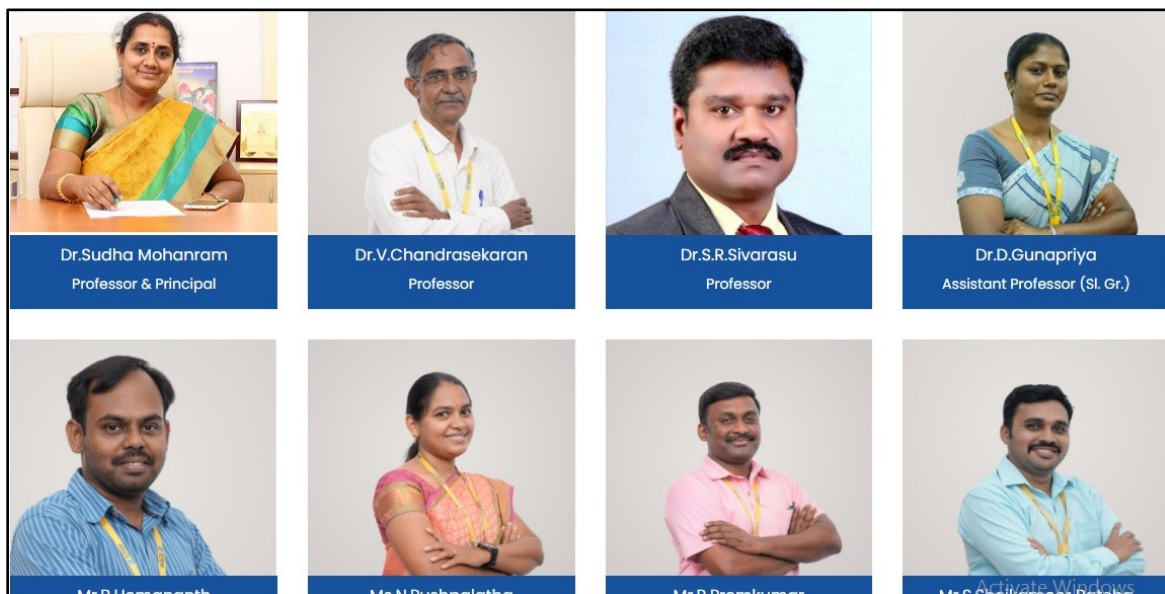


Fig 15: Faculty Profile – EEE Dept showing gender equity
